Roles and Responsibilities

1. To be the main link with the COT research and development board
2. To attend at least one of the Specialist Section Clinical Forum meetings per year in partnership with the practice and education lead.
3. To ensure the research objectives are updated in line with COT and research priorities identified by the membership.
4. To evaluate the clinical leaflets and support the production of practice guidelines.
5. To keep the SS - Children, Young People and Families research webpage up to date.

General Duties

1. To take part in the NEC as a full committee member to attend NEC meetings and contribute to the work of the committee.
2. To promote the role and function of the SS - Children, Young People and Families in liaison with other NEC members.
3. To keep a correspondence file in which all SS - Children, Young People and Families correspondence is retained for a minimum of two years (after which significant items are passed to the COT for archiving).
4. To submit documented claims for expenses incurred on behalf of the SS - Children, Young People and Families to the treasurer on a regular basis.
